## Skid Steer

8 hours – Client provides the equipment

**\*\*\*Note:** All equipment must have valid licensing, insurance, annual inspection certificate and be in sound mechanical and structural condition. Equipment that does not meet these requirements will not be allowed for use for the practical training and demonstration.

### After completing this training, participants will:

- Understand the design and limitations of a skid steer loader.
- Know how to conduct a pre-use inspection of a skid steer loader.
- Demonstrate safe operating procedures of a skid steer loader.
- Know the roles and responsibilities for the safe operation of a skid steer loader and its attachments

### Course Outline

- Classroom training – 3 hours of lecture and videos.
- Practical training – 3 hours of demonstration and hands-on training followed by a proficiency demonstration.
- Evaluation – evaluation of operator performance

### For successful completion of this training, participants will:

- Complete a knowledge-based written review.
- Demonstrate completion of a pre-use inspection and safe operation of a skid steer loader.

### Who Should Attend The Skid Steer Loader Training Course?

Those who are required to operate and use a skid steer loader or supervise those who do. Participants will learn safe operating practices and procedures for the safe operation of a loader. Statistics show that trained operators are less likely to become involved in costly incidents that cause personal injury, property damage or product loss.

This course includes:

- Fundamentals of safe loader operation
- Pre use inspections
- Safe operation of the loader and associated attachments
- Safe handling of loads
- Safe task procedures
- Workplace Health and Safety Regulations in respect to the operation of mobile equipment.

This training course is designed to point out some of the basic safety precautions that should be taken in the daily operation of loaders. Which includes maintenance, recommended pre start inspections and monthly inspections.

We will not be able to demonstrate to you all of the safe operation of the many attachments that can be associated with a loader.

It is important that you read, understand and comply with both the provincial regulations and the manufacturers manual regarding the operation of your Skid Steer.
