Wheeled Loader

After completing this training, participants will:

- Understand the design and limitations of a wheeled loader.
- Know how to conduct a pre-use inspection of a wheeled loader.
- Demonstrate safe operating procedures of a wheeled loader.
- Know the roles and responsibilities for the safe operation of a wheeled loader and it's attachments

Course Outline

- Classroom training – four hours of lecture and videos.
- Practical training – four hours of demonstration and hands-on training followed by a proficiency demonstration.
- Evaluation – evaluation of operator performance

For successful completion of this training, participants will:

- Complete a knowledge-based written review.
- Demonstrate completion of a pre-use inspection and safe operation of a wheeled loader.

This course is designed for those required to operate and use a wheeled loader or supervise those who do. Participants will learn safe operating practices and procedures for the safe operation of a wheeled loader. Statistics show that trained operators are less likely to become involved in costly incidents that cause personal injury, property damage or product loss.

This course includes:

- Fundamentals of safe wheeled loader operation
- Pre use inspections
- Safe operation of the wheeled loader and associated attachments
- Safe handling of loads
- Safe task procedures
- Workplace Health and Safety Regulations in respect to the operation of mobile equipment.

This training course is designed to point out some of the basic safety precautions that should be taken in the daily operation of wheeled loaders. Which includes maintenance, recommended pre start inspections and monthly inspections.

We will not be able to demonstrate to you all of the safe operation of the many attachments that can be associated with a wheeled loader.

It is important that you read, understand and comply with both the provincial regulations and the manufacturers manual regarding the operation of your wheeled loader.

If your wheeled loader is not equipped with the manufacturer's operators' manual, get a replacement from your dealer and keep it in your loader for quick and easy reference
