UTV - Utility Terrain Vehicle

8 hours

Prerequisites:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- PPE - CSA approved helmet, steel toe boots, gloves and weather appropriate clothing
- Government Issued Photo I.D.
- ATV (1 per person)

A UTV is designed to be a safe vehicle when used as intended. The key to safe operation is knowledge of the vehicle; recognizing and accepting it as a motorized vehicle; respecting its capabilities and its limitations; varying operating conditions; and good judgement and courtesy. Recognizing your own capabilities and limitations is also a very important factor for the safe operation of your UTV.

Students learn about controls, reading terrain, turning, climbing hills, loading & off-loading and winching techniques.
