## Rough Terrain Fork Lift – Industrial Lift Truck

8 hours – Client provides the equipment

**\*\*\*Note:** All equipment must have valid licensing, insurance, annual inspection certificate and be in sound mechanical and structural condition. Equipment that does not meet these requirements will not be allowed for use for the practical training and demonstration.

After completing this training, participants will:

- Understand the design and limitations of a rough terrain Lift Truck .
- Know how to conduct a pre-use inspection of a rough terrain Lift Truck.
- Demonstrate safe operating procedures of a rough terrain Lift Truck.
- Know the roles and responsibilities for the safe operation of a rough terrain Lift Truck and it's attachments
- Read understand load charts and set up procedures for a rough terrain lift truck

Course Outline

- Classroom training – 3 hours of lecture and videos.
- Practical training – 5 hours of demonstration and hands-on training followed by a proficiency demonstration.
- Evaluation – evaluation of operator performance

For successful completion of this training, participants will:

- Complete a knowledge-based written review.
- Demonstrate completion of a pre-use inspection and safe operation of a rough terrain Lift Truck.

Who Should Attend The Rough Terrain Lift Truck Training Course?

Those who are required to operate and use or supervise a rough terrain Lift Truck. Participants will learn safe operating practices and procedures for the safe operation of a rough terrain Lift Truck. Statistics show that trained operators are less likely to become involved in costly incidents that cause personal injury, property damage or product loss.

This course includes:

- Fundamentals of safe a rough terrain Lift Truck operation
- Pre use inspections
- Safe operation of the rough terrain Lift Truck and associated attachments
- Safe handling of loads (reading load charts)
- Safe task procedures (set u and lift procedures)
- Workplace Health and Safety Regulations in respect to the operation of mobile equipment.

This training course is designed to point out some of the basic safety precautions that should be taken in the daily operation of a rough terrain Lift Truck. Which includes maintenance, recommended pre start inspections and monthly inspections.

We will not be able to demonstrate to you all of the safe operation of the many attachments that can be associated with a rough terrain Lift Truck.

It is important that you read, understand and comply with both the provincial regulations and the manufacturers manual regarding the operation of your rough terrain Lift Truck.

Note the rough terrain Lift Truck training listed above is designed for inexperienced operators not for green or first time operators. The training is for telescopic boom lift trucks not wheeled loaders with masts or fork attachments on booms.

Fork Truck Classifications

- I Electric motor rider trucks
- II Electric motor narrow aisle trucks
- III Electric motor hand trucks or hand/rider trucks
- IV Internal combustion engine trucks with solid or cushion tires
- V Internal combustion engine trucks with pneumatic tires
- VI Electric and internal combustion engine tractors
- **VII Rough terrain forklift trucks**
